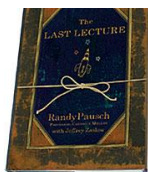
This is a moving story of the relationship between a guy who ran a cash register and a guy who worked at a college. The cashier taught life lessons and the college guy listened.

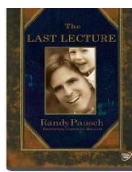
